









## How to use the Protector Vehicle Interlock

		
<p><b>1</b> First, connect the black cable to your ALCOLIMIT Protector handset. <b>'i9'</b> will appear on the display indicating the handset is correctly attached.</p>	<p><b>2</b> Place your key in the ignition to the ON position</p>	<p><b>3</b> Turn your ALCOLIMIT Protector on, depress the ON/OFF button for 2 seconds until the screen turns on. The unit will commence a start up process. This process generally takes 30 seconds but can last 2 minutes.</p>
		
<p><b>4</b> The unit is ready when two beeps sound and the word <b>blow</b> appears on the display</p>	<p><b>5</b> Attach the mouthpiece tube and blow one consistent deep breath into the sensor. There will be a continual long beep while you are blowing. A full lung of air is required. Once your ALCOLIMIT Protector has received enough airflow you will hear a double click signalling you to stop.</p>	<p><b>6</b> A zero will scroll across the screen while it's analysing. Your %BAC will then be displayed. Eg. 0.045%BAC</p>
		<p><b>9</b> For readings of 0.020%BAC and above the reading will simply appear and you will NOT be able to start your vehicle.  Please wait and retest in 1 hour time.</p>
<p><b>7</b> Readings below 0.020%BAC will be followed by the word PASS.</p>	<p><b>8</b> You can then start your vehicle</p>
